Course overview	The course targets the students who already studied the Applied Behavior Analysis and wish to learn more specific supporting methods. In the course, students will participate in teaching of infant with autism spectrum disorders to learn basic approaching technology.
Remarks	It is preferable that students have already obtained the credit of Basic Lecture on Applied Behavior Analysis and the Advanced Topics in Applied Behavior Analysis in advance.
Teaching method	Training, experiments and skill
Attainment target	Students will learn the supporting techniques of the applied behavior analysis.
Teaching schedule	Students will participate, once a week, in teaching of children with autistic disorders or children with intellectual disabilities with significant behavioral problems. Teaching method of this course is based on the approach of the behavioral therapy and the applied behavior analysis. Students will participate in teaching of the subject children as one of staff under the instructions of supervisors. Students will participate, not only in the time of direct teaching of children, but also in the time of pre-class meeting, case discussion, and post-class meeting. These meetings will be held to assess the behavior of the subject children, formulate the teaching programs, and modify the teaching programs. The evaluation of students' performance, therefore, will include not only the participation into teaching, but also into these pre- and post-meetings. Students are requested to take part in all these meetings, unless there are special circumstances. Although no particular textbook is specified, it is preferable that students will read the above reference books and other materials on the applied behavior analysis and understand the meaning of technical terms in advance.

Homework	Students are requested to participate into a pre-class group meeting and draft their own program for teaching. Then, they will receive the guidance for modification on their program from a group leader before actually implementing it in the class. After the class, the students will also receive the guidance from supervisor and review their own program executed, and reflect any improvement in formulation of a teaching program next week.
